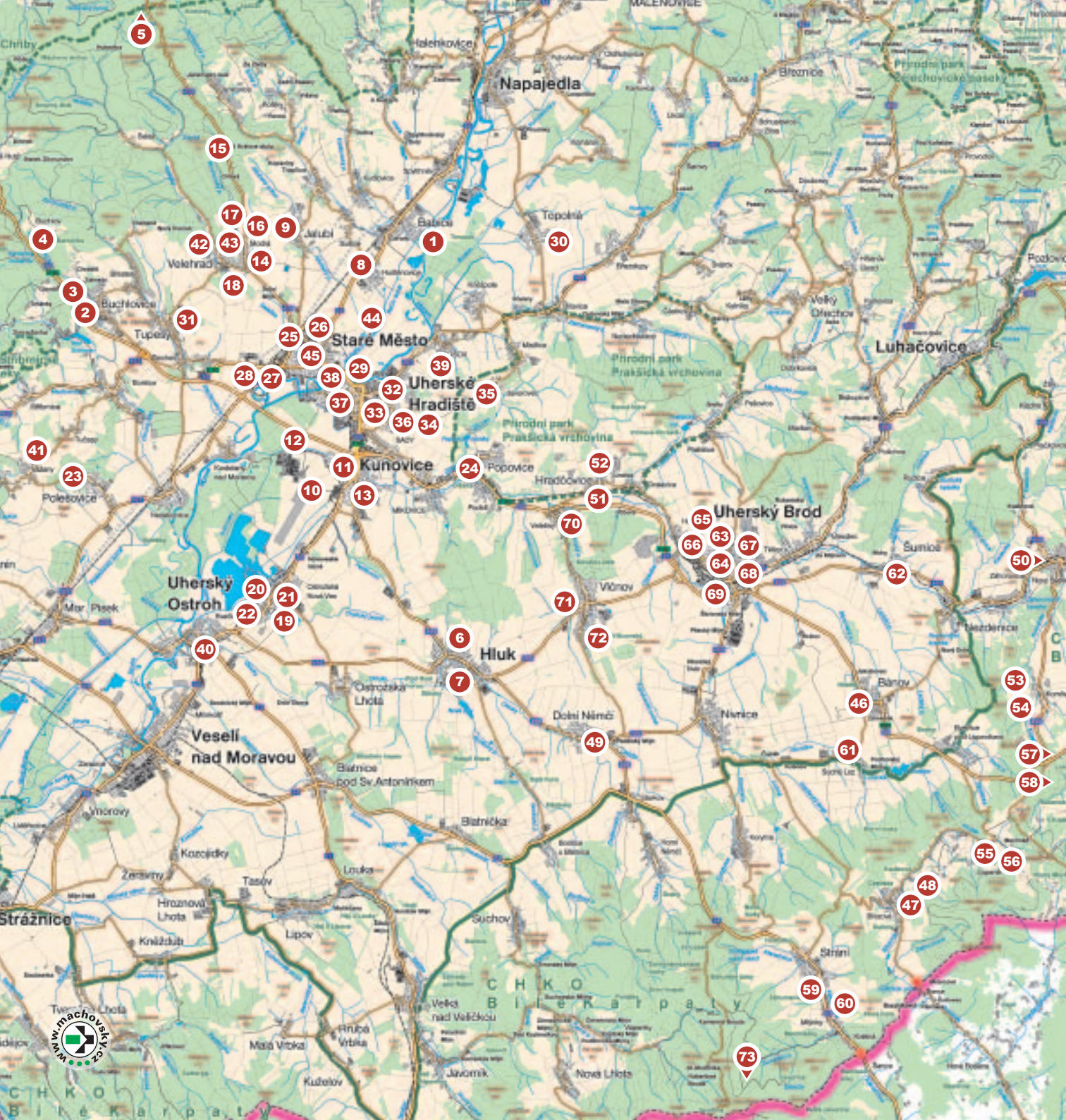

There is a museum, a gallery and a Tourist Information Centre Buchlovice in the Podhradí Museum. A ground floor exhibition is separated into 14 parts while each is dedicated to one village in this region or to some other place that has a partnership with Buchlovice. A permanent exhibition about Buchlovice is located on the first floor and contains more than 500 items such as various objects, writings or documents.

Buchlovice Chateau was built in style of Italian Baroque and is one of the most romantic buildings in Moravia. Interiors are richly decorated with parquets and paintings. The chateau is embedded in a vast splendid park having a middle-European importance. One may visit a beautiful exhibition of fuchsias, an art gallery, a recently opened animal rescue station, or a wine gallery situated in the chateau cellars.

Buchlov Castle ranks among the best-known medieval castles in Moravia. The castle keeps a stylish exhibition of original furniture, science collections, and a well-equipped library. Besides, the visitors may take an amazing look from the castle's tower. The Chapel of St. Barbora is located nearby.

Do not miss the opportunity to enjoy an outstanding view from the highest lookout tower in Moravia that was built in 2004 on the top of the Brdo hill in Chřibý Mountains. The tower is unique as it has been the first lookout tower made of stone in the Czech Republic since the 1930s.

The tower is one of the dominants in the town. This water fortress from the 14<sup>th</sup> century underwent a Renaissance reconstruction during the 16th century. A small museum that collects archeological relics and other historical and cultural heritage of the town is situated on the top floor of the fortress. The tower offers an amazing outlook over the town and the White Carpathians.

The houses represent a typical traditional way of living in Dolňácko region. In one of the houses is an ancient oven for baking bread and a black kitchen originating from 1830. The second house was built at the turn of the last century. It consists of a main house-place where several local costumes are displayed. Both houses are equipped with traditional furniture and a rich inventory of house tools.

The trail stretches along the Bata Canal. Its five stops introduce some of the preserved remains in the floodplain forests along the river Morava. In spring, one may observe characteristic flowers in bloom—yellow iris, water violet. This area also serves as a breeding place for nightingales whose singing often resounds all around.

A stone replica of an original windmill stands near Jalubí village. It was put up on the authentic foundations. The constructors used the same technologies and materials as it was in the original building. The object is 11 metres high and has 7 metres in diameter. Some historic materials document the existence of the windmill as early as in the first half of the 19th century. Reconstruction of the new windmill was supported by the Jalubí village as well as by Zlín region in 2007 and 2008.

A unique collection of aircraft numbers more than twenty pieces and documents well the history of aircraft production in this region. Besides, it introduces the basic equipment of the Czech Air Force. The exhibition includes types L-410, L-29, Ilyushin 14, MiG aircrafts, Trener, C-11 and others. Tickets for sightseeing flights, balloon flights and tandem jumping are available at the airport.

The heritage house is one of the sightseeings representing a Slovácko folk architecture. The house was raised at the beginning of the 19th century. An entrance to the house leads you through a black kitchen, on the right handside there is a main room with a tile stove and other traditional equipments such as a holy corner decorated with pictures of saints. Holy corners had a sacrificial function in houses. The exposition also introduces housing conditions in Kunovice until the 1930s.

Ten stops of the informative nature trail show us the population of floodplain forest along the river Morava. It introduces representatives of flora and fauna living in particular biotopes. During your walk, you may observe a very rare stag beetle or a vast field of ramsons.



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The forest has been modified and equipped with nature playgrounds, sandpits and sawdusted running tracks.

St. Peter and Pavel Church, the most significant cultural monument in Kunovice, originates from the Gothic era. The current shape was brought forth in the 18th century. In 2006, the town invested in a reconstruction of a surrounding garden and varied it with a group of statues illustrating Jesus Christ with his Apostles. Despite its position close to a main street, this extraordinary piece of art creates a milieu suitable for calm meditation.

The open-air archeological museum in Modrá is situated in the locality of an original Great Moravian settlement in the nearby neighborhood of Velehrad. It gives us a vivid picture of a Slavic settlement. The buildings were constructed according to the results of archeological findings in this locality and were consequently followed by hypothetical reconstructions.

Many cultural events take place here during the main season while

most of them are inspired by the Slavic history. The Open-air Archeological Museum in Modrá is a unique project one would hardly find anywhere else in the Czech Republic. In 2004, it was awarded a Golden Brick Prize in a Program of Village Revitalization within the Zlín region. In 2009, it scored in a program called Escape from Boredom winning the first prize for the South Moravian region.

A huge stone called The King's Seat lies about 4 km northwards from Modrá. Based on several archeological findings it is believed that the stone used to be a part of a pre-historic solar calendar. A number of engravings have been found on the stone. Some of them are identical with Celtic runes. During the following centuries, the stone became an important landmark. One of the legends says that king Přemysl Otakar I. rested on this place a couple of times.

Apparently, this church was originally designated for local magnates, which shows evidence of Great Moravian Christianization. Foundation walls were discovered in 1911. More than 37 graves with skeletons were explored around the church. A hypothetical reconstruction of the church was raised up near these archeological findings in 2000.

Exhibitions in the museum are dedicated to the Kunovice region folk costumes. They introduce history and many variants that appeared during centuries. There are more than twenty full-sized figurines displayed as well as five examples of children's costumes. Besides the costumes, many other exhibits present a traditional way of living—curd presses, hampers, feast warrants, garlands or painted Easter eggs. Such compact fund of this microregion's folk art would hardly be found anywhere else.

“Špitálky” is an important locality in the southwest part of Staré Město. It is a reconstructed groundplan depicting a part of a Great Moravian church from the 9<sup>th</sup> century and a graveyard consisting of 56 skeleton graves. The graves contained rich gifts such as a silver trap with an engraving of a hunter, which testifies to the presence of Moravian magnates. This unique artifact and many others are deposited in the Great Moravian Memorial.

A superb lighthouse and a lookout tower in one was built in an industrial part of Staré Město. You have to climb 96 stairs up to the top from which you may watch a colourful landscape of Chřiby Mountains, Buchlov castle and the White Carpathians.

The house no. 90 used to be a farmhouse with a leveled food storeroom. A neighbouring outhouse consists of a jointure house and a small smithery. The whole complex was completed with a copy of a barn in 1996 and a draw well in 1998.

The house no. 93 was originally also a farmhouse with a leveled food storeroom, an outhouse and a jointure house. Besides, there are well-preserved stables with farming tools and an exhibition of fishery or an old laundry.

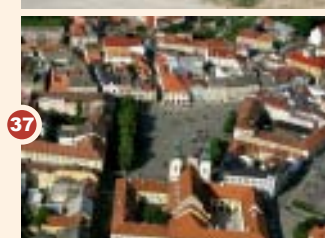

ing view opens in front of your  
eyes. Eastwards there are the White  
Carpathians with its highest moun-  
tain Velká Javořina, western line is

tle. Northern panorama consists of  
three parts – Napajedla passage  
between Hostýnské Hills and Vi-  
zovice Hills.

Right in the heart of Velehrad stands a precious gem of Moravian Baroque—a three-aisled richly decorated basilica. Pope Jan Pavel II. visited the Basilica on April 22, 1990.

The stone collection that is situated in the underground of the Basilica of the Assumption of Our Lady and Sts. Cyril and Methodius documents the original shape of the Roman monastery.

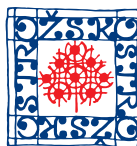
